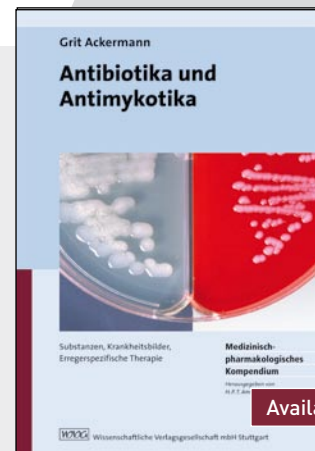

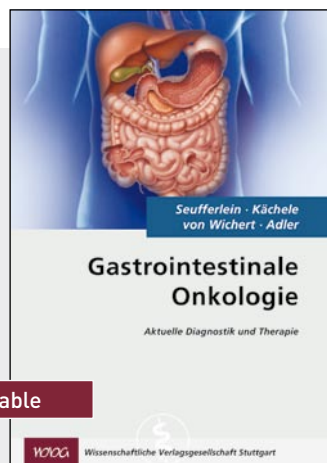

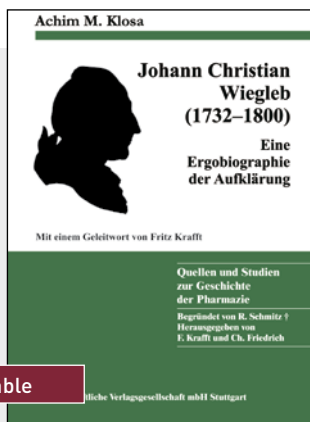

Johann Christian Wiegleb (1732-1800)

An Ergobiography from the Age of Enlightenment

The pharmacist Johann Christian Wiegleb (1732-1800) of Langensalza was one of the most important figures in pharmacy and chemistry in that age of great changes in the second half of the 18th century. He played a major role in important steps along pharmacy's path from a trade to an academic science. Driven by the Enlightenment's concept of utility, he dedicated himself to questions of general theoretical chemistry and problems of analytical chemistry and chemical technology, wrote textbooks and references, and made himself a name as the author of chemistry works debunking magic and alchemy that were written for the general public. He had a lasting effect by running a school and boarding house for young pharmacists and chemists for some twenty years from 1779 on. It was the first private institution of its kind in Germany and became the model for numerous other schools, representing a first important step toward establishing an academic training for pharmacists at universities.

Foundation and development of a professional organization

This scientific study of the almost 100-year history of the German Society of Hospital Pharmacists (ADKA) closes two kinds of gaps in pharmaceutical historiography. On the one hand it complements existing studies on the history of other societies and associations of German pharmacists such as the German pharmaceutical society Deutsche Pharmazeutische Gesellschaft (DPhG) or the Federal Union of German Associations of Pharmacists (ABDA). In addition, it also makes a contribution to the history of hospital pharmacies, an aspect of pharmacy history which has not yet been investigated in depth, because most publications concentrate on the history of individual pharmacies or the biography of their owners. The study presented here evaluates numerous secondary sources, particularly archives preserving minutes of ADKA meetings and letters from hospital pharmacies and reports from contemporaries.
